DRAG SHOE AWARENESS: Avoid turning with brooms down. Consider drag brushes.

STAY ON TRACK: Follow the milling pattern precisely.

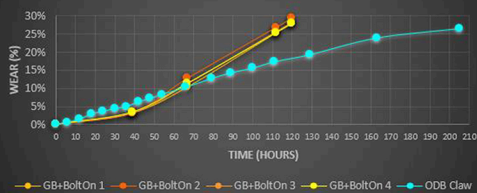
